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
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1. General reading information

CoStra is conceptualised as a trend study and stands out due to its specific focus on the three main topics of interest. On the one hand, it thoroughly addresses family dynamics and division of household chores and childcare by looking at attitudes, concrete tasks distribution within couples, and satisfaction with family arrangements during the pandemic. On the other hand, it highlights social interactions under the conditions of social distancing, as well as individual mobility and tourism behaviour in the times of restricted travel regulations.

The first wave of the survey took place from May 27, 2020 to July 27, 2020 and was created and carried out using the online survey application LimeSurvey (Version 3.26.0). The processing of the exported results was carried out with the statistical software IBM SPSS Statistics 26 and can be made available upon request. Only those variables that are relevant in terms of content are listed below. Existing system variables, which automatically include information such as the time and duration of the survey, are not shown in the codebook. The variables are arranged according to their sequence in the questionnaire, with several successive items in matrices being summarised under a strain identification. Those variables affected by filtering are supplemented with information about the filter setting. Answers to the open questions can be viewed on request. The generated variable version with the ending " num" contains the specification of system-defined-missings.
