- The accepted manuscript immediately after acceptance by AIP Publishing
- The Version of Record 12 months after publication by AIP Publishing
- Credit line must be included that references the full citation for the published paper, along with a link to the VOR after publication on AIP Publishing's site

Please give me a binding commitment if all authors of Leibniz University Hannover can publish their publications in the Leibniz University Hannover's Institutional Repository under the conditions mentioned above.
